



## Buglers and footballers to pause and reflect

Surround-sound bugle calls will herald the Remembrance Day message in Adelaide this Friday (November 11). In addition to the traditional service on North Terrace, the RSL will place a bugler at each of these four key locations:

- Telstra House, 30 Pirie St
- Victoria Square, opposite SA Water
- Credit Union SA, 400 King William St
- Naval, Military and Air Force Club, 111 Hutt St

They will sound *Last Post* at 11am, followed by a minute's silence and then Rouse. "We're re-creating the mood of remembrance and respect for the fallen that prevailed in the 1950s," says Julia Langrehr, chief executive officer of the RSL-SA. "Back in those days, people would stop in the street – and even climb out of their cars – and observe a minute's silence."

To complete this mood, people are asked to buy a poppy from the team of RSL collectors. The annual Poppy Appeal raises essential funds for current and former members of the Defence Forces, and their dependants, at times of need. It supports such vital causes as assistance dogs for veterans with PTSD, and the RSL's emergency housing program for homeless veterans.

The traditional Remembrance Day Service will commence at 10.45am at the SA National War Memorial, North Terrace, and will pause at 11.00am for the *Last Post* and minute's silence. A number of state dignitaries will be attending and the service is open to the general public.

On the sports field this Friday night, Adelaide United will wear a Remembrance Day strip for its A-League clash with Brisbane Roar (Coopers Stadium 7.20pm). The design features the poppy appeal logo and \$20 from every sale will be donated to the Poppy Appeal. The game will commence with a formal remembrance ceremony and a minute's silence, and conclude with presentation of the Tomas Dale medal. Private Dale, aged 21, from Reynella, was an Adelaide soldier and soccer enthusiast, killed in 2010 by a roadside bomb in Afghanistan.
