



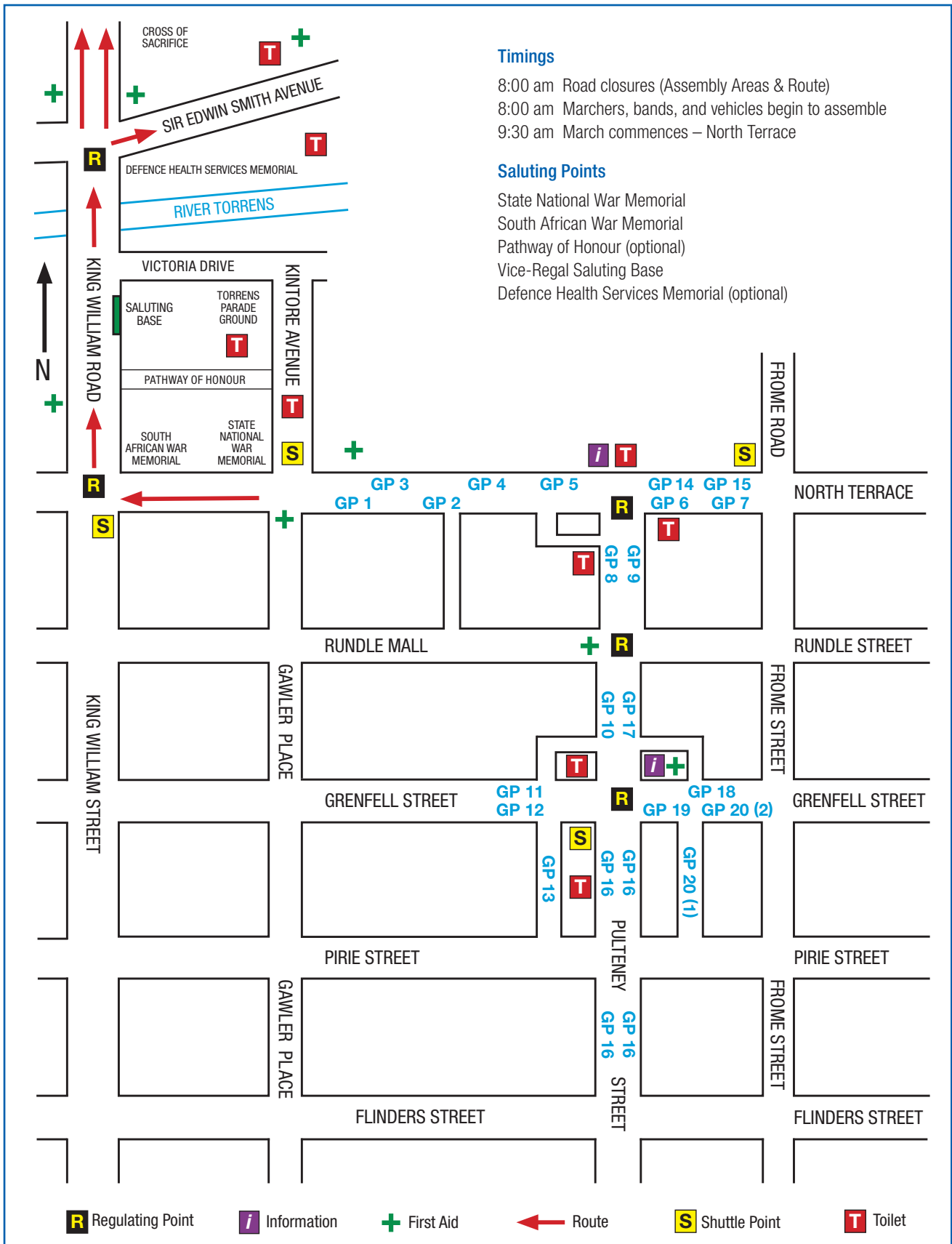

# ADELAIDE ANZAC DAY MARCH - 2017

Commences at 9:30 am from the corner of North Terrace and Gawler Place



## Assembly, Frontages, and Commencement of the March

**Assembly:** Public vehicle traffic in the Assembly Areas, and along the March route, will cease at 8:00 am to allow marshalling to commence.

**Transport to Assembly Areas:** Veterans may travel to their Assembly Areas using one of the Rundle Mall Management Authority's shuttle services between 8:00 am and 10:00 am. Please see yellow symbols on map for locations of Shuttle Points.

**Frontages:** All units (less bands) are to march 6-abreast.

**March Commencement:** On North Terrace, just east of Gawler Place at 9:30 am.

**Reviewing Officer:** His Excellency The Governor of South Australia will review the March from the Official Dais.

## Dispersal Details for Marching Units & Bands, and for Veterans in Vehicles

**The best positions for spectators** to view the march are along North Terrace, and along King William Road, south of the Adelaide Bridge.

**Units and bands will be diverted** either north along King William Road (on either side of the traffic island) or east into Sir Edwin Smith Avenue.

**Veterans travelling in vehicles** during the march will disembark on the western side of Sir Edwin Smith Avenue, north of Pennington Terrace.

## FIRST DELIBERATE GAP

Once the Group 5 Transport Vehicle pod has moved-off, a deliberate gap of **100 metres** is to be maintained between the end of the vehicle pod and the larger buses referred to below.

## ALL LARGER BUSES

The first deliberate gap (referred to above) is to be followed by all buses larger than a 22 seat minibus.

The 100 metre gap ahead of these buses **will be maintained** by the driver of the lead bus.

## SECOND DELIBERATE GAP

An additional, deliberate gap of **100 metres** will be established between the last of the larger buses, and the first unit of Group 6.

This gap may decrease (**to no less than 50 metres**) during the March, as the bands in Groups 6 to 20 will march at 108 paces per minute.
